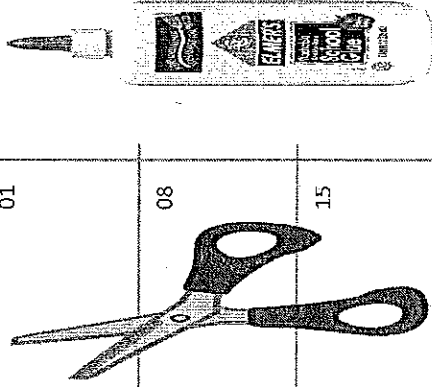

## Messages from the Health Office

All immunizations must be up-to-date prior to your student entering school.

Emergency cards and other health related documents will be distributed on the first day of school. **They are due back to school on the following day.** If your contact information changes during the year, please let us know.

### Absences/illnesses/injuries:

If your child is going to be absent from school, please call the school by **8:30 a.m.** Should your child become ill during the evening with obvious symptoms such as fever, vomiting, etc., please keep him/her home from school for at least 24 hours after the symptoms have subsided.

A **note from the doctor** should be submitted if there is a suspicion of a contagious illness (strep throat, pink eye, rash, etc). A good rule of thumb is that if the child was taken to the MD for an evaluation, a doctor's note should be submitted. Otherwise a **parent note** regarding the child's absence should be submitted.

Children may have injuries that occur at home or at after-school activities that may restrict their activity or performance at school. There are **special instructions** that you need to discuss with the nurse for children who may have stitches, casts or crutches. Please call the nurse for these instructions prior to your child's return to school.

If your child becomes ill while school is in session the parents/guardians will be notified by the health office to come to the school and call for the student. A student is never allowed to go home alone.

### Medication/health conditions:

There are special forms that need to be completed by the child's physician and signed by the parent and MD before the child receives **medication in school.** Medication includes not only prescription but also over the counter medications as well. Please contact the nurse to obtain these forms and receive further instructions if your child will need medication in school. **Medication at home:** please inform the nurse if your child takes medication at home on a regular basis. Please inform the nurse if there are health conditions that may affect your child's performance in school.

### Physicals:

Physicals are required of all students new to the Bloomfield School District and each candidate for a school athletic team. The District recommends that your 4<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> grader have a physical exam. If you do not have a private physician, the school physician will examine the student. Physical examinations are given at the school's health office.
